



## Lockable Hinge Window Handle with Night-**Glow**® Lock

Prowler Proof Hinge Window Security Screens now come with an optional lockable handle which has been designed to be able to be used in fall prevention settings for second-storey residences.

The new handle option which includes a locking mechanism and key, means that there is less risk of accidental window opening. This means it can be used as a fall prevention product, to Child

Resistant level, however the installation it must satisfy the requirements set out in the National Construction Code, as set out overleaf.

It also includes a Night-Glow® design, it has been made from glow-in-the-dark materials, so if being used in an emergency you will be able to locate it without any problems, as it is visible and easy to find, day or night.





The key has been designed with Night-Glow® materials, to assist you should you need to find the key in the dark. The luminescent material is a 1:1 charging: emitting ratio, up to 8 hours, so if the key is in the sun during the day and absorbs light for 8 hours, it will glow, declining in brightness over the time, for 8 hours.

When installing any fall prevention screen, it must satisfy the requirements of the National Construction Code and Australian Standards 5203.

If this screen is being used as a fall prevention screen and has a locking handle with key, then the key's location plays an important part in the installation. It is a requirement of the Code that the key is located out of reach from small children.

Please follow this guide above to help identify a suitable location for the key.

Only an adult and/or responsible person should open this screen in the event of an emergency or for any other purpose, and it should be immediately relocked and the key put away in the appropriate location after use
